MAPSIGN relies on 3 key points:

- The *electronic signature* tells you who signed the document.
- Timestamping* tells you precisely when anything happens.
- Once sent, the documents are *archived* electronically for easy retrieval.

MAPSIGN uses the existing certificates used within the company or a dedicated certificate and interfaces seamlessly with Exchange, Notes, and the SMTP protocol, etc. MAPSIGN retrieves the recipients' details from an input spool file, database, or the mail system's address book.

As a result, the documents comply with the European standards of document virtualization.
